# Taxi helps build home for youth

TAXIS usually take people home, but a special donation by a Kelvin Grove taxi company will help build a home.

KG Taxi Maintenance recently gifted an ex-taxi worth \$4000 to homeless youth charity Kids Under Cover.

The car was collected and sold, at no charge, by Eagle Farm auction house Mannheim. The proceeds will go toward a scholarship and mentoring scheme and to build backyard shelters for at-risk or homeless youth.

KG Taxi Maintenance spokesman Gerry Di Lucchio said the company was planning on gifting two more cars.

“As a family man with young kids, I hate to think that there’s children out there struggling to put a roof over their heads or to eat,” Mr Di Lucchio said.

Kids Under Cover CEO Jo Swift said more than 3400 cars had been donated nationwide since 2006.
